The success of our Fun-Raiser Party will depend upon the Goods and Services donated ... your help is greatly appreciated! The procurement deadline is **Friday, September 16, 2016**.

How do I procure?

Procuring does not mean purchasing, but rather generating. Unless you are inclined, you need not purchase items to donate to the auction. Should you choose to buy an item or gift certificate, ask the merchant to match your purchase and you have twice the donation. Items are tax deductible donations and donors will be provided with a receipt.

What do I procure?

Think about what you, your family, acquaintances and the businesses you patronize can donate. Individual items can be combined with other items to create amazing packages.
